While the numbers in our Fast Facts speak to our work's growing reach, our participants' individual stories capture the depth.

At Tasks' Northeast Outreach and Opportunity Center (NOOC) in NE Minneapolis, we offer a warm and welcoming space where people experiencing homelessness can find support.

For one recent visitor, this **led to newfound stability in both housing and employment:** she found janitorial work through Tasks' Job Training Program, which set her up to sign a lease on a new apartment in October.

Meanwhile, another Tasks participant found a similar range of holistic success after moving into our Transition Lodge. Upon entry they were homeless, unemployed, and had no mental health services in place. Partnering with Tasks' Lodge and Resource Center staff, the participant secured **stable housing**, a job, healthcare benefits, and psychiatric services.

As we have shared in previous newsletters, Tasks has responded to rising mental health needs by **ramping up our Case Management services.** One participant began her case management journey afraid to step outside her home. After working with her Tasks case manager, she found the footing she needed to make new strides, spending a recent weekend on a family vacation out of town.

From people dropping in for services at our Resource Center to staff forging new partnerships to better support program participants, it's been a busy season at Tasks Unlimited!

Here are a few quick highlights:

Our Tasks Resource Center drop-in site on Nicollet Avenue continues to be a safe space for people to find low-barrier mental health services, employment, referrals to healthcare, housing, and other resources.

Since February, we have completed **85 new intakes at the Center.**

Our lodges are filling up and continue to provide stable and safe housing while also offering community.

In partnership with Labor Retreat Apartments, we have expanded our reach in the community. We met with more than 50 residents who are motivated to find work.
